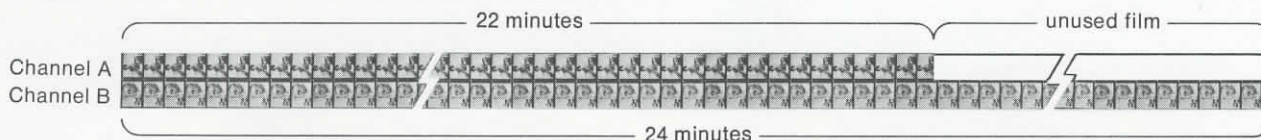

Preparing your order for EVR™ Cartridges

1. Prices shown are per cartridge, and include all conversion costs of your material to EVR™ Cartridges.
2. The EVR™ Cartridge provides a maximum of 25 minutes on each of 2 channels for a total of 50 minutes.
3. Cartridge costs are twice the running time of the LONGER of the two channels, rounded up to the next 5-minute increment.

EXAMPLE: The longer of these two programs is the one on channel B, which is 24 minutes. The shorter is channel A, 22 minutes. Simply double 24 and round up to next 5-minute increment.



24 minutes x 2 = 48, which rounds up to 50 minutes. Cost is calculated on a 50 minute program base.

NOTE: It is advisable to specify programs of equal length on each channel of a cartridge, to take full advantage of film footage and enjoy lowest cost.

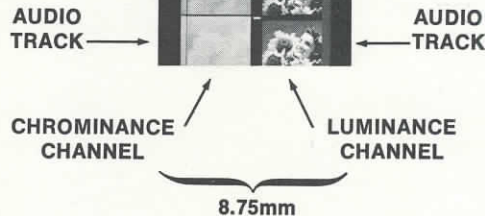
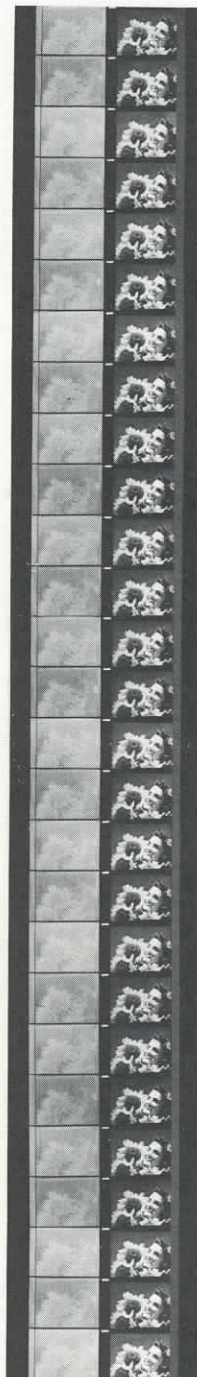

Illustrated above, three times its actual size, is a segment of EVR Film in the color format. The chrominance channel provides color information, while the luminance channel contains the actual picture. These are combined in the EVR Player to provide up to 25 minutes of color pictures with sound.
